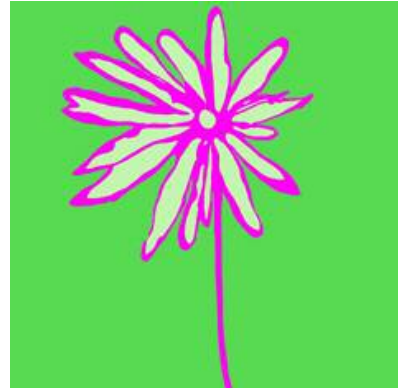


FOCUS ON KATE KNIGHT FROM THE UK
